Policy on Use of Church Facilities and Property

Pine Ridge Bible Church wishes to encourage the use of the church facilities by church members (& regular attenders) when church activities are not scheduled. The following regulations apply to use of the church building.

1. The church building is not to be used for any business or for-profit activities. Groups wishing to conduct activities about which there is question will be referred to the Elder/Deacon Board.
2. Anyone using the church facilities at any time will have in their presence a voting-age member in good standing of Pine Ridge Bible Church, or a person approved by a member of the Deacon/Elder Board.
3. The time and date of desired use of the church facilities must be scheduled with the Pastor and recorded on the church calendar. Church activities will take priority over member use.
4. No smoking or alcoholic beverages or unacceptable music will be permitted on church property.
5. No social dancing is permitted at Pine Ridge Bible Church.
6. All food and beverage consumption must take place downstairs in the fellowship hall.
7. The person in charge will ensure restoration and clean-up of the church facility. This includes, but is not limited to, making sure that no water is left running, that all exterior doors and windows are shut and locked, and that all unneeded lights are turned off.
